



Showerbird Set-Up Instructions

Showerbird® was designed specifically for safe, in-home avian bathing, making regular showers simple, gentle, and repeatable. With a one-time setup, Showerbird turns bird bathing into an effortless routine, encouraging healthy bathing 3–5 times per week-or more!

The Showerbird® home shower setup is compatible with all standard bathroom showers and installs as easily as replacing your showerhead.

There are two options available for your in-home set-up: Shower Diverter or Sink Adapter

STEP 1- Remove your existing showerhead and install the Showerbird® Shower Diverter in its place. You can then reattach your original showerhead to the diverter for normal home shower use.

STEP 2- Screw the provided Showerbird® **female-threaded adapter** onto the additional threaded port on the diverter. The diverter toggle allows you to switch between your regular shower and the Showerbird® system whenever needed.

STEP 3- That's It! Connect the Showerbird® Quick-Connect for easy, effortless bathing anytime!

Sink Set-Up Option (may not be compatible)



If your sink faucet has a removable aerator, simply unscrew and remove it, then install the provided Showerbird® **male-threaded adapter** in its place.

Note: Some newer faucet models may not be compatible.

After Showering

Disconnect the Showerbird® Quick-Connect unit. Drain water out of the hose through the coupler end and hang the Showerbird® over your shower rod or home showerhead to dry.

* As with any plumbing connection, we recommend using plumber's tape on all fittings. Even small gaps can lead to small drips, as water pressure will always find an escape point. Showerbird® has made every effort to alleviate this in production, but small drips can occur. Washers are essential — if one comes loose or falls out, be sure to reinstall it before use.

Showerbird® -Bird Showering Instructions

Caution: Read Before Using

Showerbird® is engineered to support the natural bathing behaviors of companion exotic birds. The precision mist tip produces a hybrid-soft spray suitable for a wide range of species.

Proper bird bathing is more than connecting your Showerbird® and spraying your companion. A calm, natural approach builds trust and encourages healthy behavior.

How to Mist Properly

Always let the mist fall like rain. The ergonomic 18” wand design allows natural space.

Hold the Showerbird® wand **above your bird’s head** and allow the fine mist to gently fall downward.

- Do not spray directly into the face or body.
- Allow your bird to move, lift wings, turn, or step away.
- The bird should always feel in control.

This overhead “rainfall” method supports natural posture and reduces stress.

-Know Your Bird’s Natural Climate

Companion birds originate from different environments:

- Tropical species may prefer warmer mist.
- Rainforest species may tolerate cooler, rain-like water.
- Some birds enjoy heavy soaking; others prefer light misting.

Water temperature and frequency vary by species. Research your bird’s specific needs using its full species name. Showerbird® recommends the following helpful resources:

- **Trusted online research tools such as ChatGPT or Google**
- **Showerbird® website for some species**
- **Avian veterinary guidance**

Temperature & Safety

- Use lukewarm water unless species research suggests otherwise.
- Never use hot water.
- Avoid sudden temperature changes.

If your bird appears stressed or steps away, stop and try again another day.
