



Companion Parrot Bathing Guide

Recommended Home Bathing Temperature (All Species)

- Use lukewarm water: 95–105°F
 - Room should be draft-free (70°F+ recommended)
 - Mist should fall gently from above the head
 - Never spray directly into face or nostrils
 - Allow bird to air dry in a warm environment

Species Bathing Recommendations

- **African Greys:** 2–4x weekly | High dander | 95–105°F
- **Cockatoos:** 2–4x weekly | Powder-down species | 95–105°F
- **Amazon Parrots:** 1–3x weekly | Enjoy engagement | 95–105°F
- **Macaws:** 1–3x weekly | Large feather coverage | 95–105°F
- **Eclectus:** 2–3x weekly | Feather-sensitive | 95–100°F
- **Conures (Green-Cheek, Sun, etc.):** 2–3x weekly | Gentle overhead mist | 95–100°F
- **Indian Ringnecks:** 1–3x weekly | Independent | 95–100°F
- **Quakers (where legal):** 1–3x weekly | Controlled mist preferred | 95–100°F
- **Caiques:** 2–3x weekly | Active bathers | 95–100°F
